## About the Sacred Heart Devotion Group

The Sacred Heart Devotion Group is a community of Catholic laity in Lehigh Valley, PA whose goal is to venerate and adore the Sacred Heart of Our Lord and participate in the abundant graces He promises to those who practice this devotion.

The practice of the devotion to the Sacred Heart came from a series of apparitions to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque from 1673 to 1675. During these apparitions, Christ asked that this devotion spread, and He gave 12 promises to those who expose and honor the Sacred Heart image.

This devotion is not limited to the members of this group alone. It is actually the duty and obligation of all Christians to practice the devotion.

## Obligations

Members of the Sacred Heart Devotion Group who seek to venerate and adore the Sacred Heart of Our Lord and who strive to practice this devotion must have a

desire to make reparation for the neglect, indifference and ingratitude of the majority that results in Jesus Christ being left alone, abandoned and forgotten on our altars, never visited to offer consolation for such neglect.

To fulfill these obligations of consecration and reparation, there are specific devotions that must be followed:

- Receive Holy Communion frequently with the intention of making reparation
- Go to confession and receive the Eucharist on the first Friday for nine consecutive months
- Attend Eucharistic Adoration once a month
- Pray the litany of the Sacred Heart as a group each month
- Pray the novena to the Sacred heart each month
- Offer daily acts of reparation
- Continually study and deepen your knowledge of the Sacred Heart
